



Announcement of the Office of the Justice Fund

Subject: No Gift Policy for the Fiscal Year 2026

In Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026), the Justice Fund marks its 11th year of operation as a key governmental mechanism in providing assistance and standing alongside the public to ensure equitable access to justice. The Office of the Justice Fund, a division-level government agency under the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Justice, is responsible for providing administrative support and driving the operations of the Justice Fund, which has juristic person status under the Justice Fund Act B.E. 2558 (2015). The Fund serves as a financial resource to assist the public in legal proceedings, applications for temporary release of suspects or defendants, remedies for violations of human rights, and the promotion of legal knowledge among citizens. The Office recognizes that corruption and misconduct pose significant threats to public trust and confidence; therefore, it places great importance on the prevention and suppression of such issues in a serious and continuous manner.

In order to demonstrate a firm commitment to combating corruption in all forms and to promote integrity, ethics, and transparency in the performance of official duties in accordance with the principles of good governance and the Code of Ethics of the Justice Fund, the Office of the Justice Fund hereby announces the No Gift Policy. All executives, officials, and personnel under the Office are strictly prohibited from requesting, accepting, or consenting to receive any property, gifts, gratuities, or other benefits in connection with or arising from the performance of their duties, whether before, during, or after such performance, on any occasion. This measure is intended to prevent unfair practices and conflicts of interest. Executives and supervisors at all levels shall serve as role models and ensure strict compliance with relevant laws, regulations, and ethical standards.
